Parl panel seeks white paper on exam leaks over 8 years

Asks For Details On Cases, Arrests & Action Taken



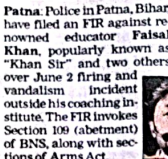

New Delhi: Parliamentary standing committee on education chairman and Congress Rajya Sabha MP Digvijaya Singh has written to Prime Minister Narendra Modi seeking a white paper on paper leaks and examination irregularities in National Testing Agency (NTA)-conducted examinations over the past eight years, arguing that greater transparency is needed to restore students' confidence in the examination system following the cancellation of NEET-UG 2026.

of cases relating to examination paper leaks and how they are being prosecuted by the CBI and other investigative agencies of the Centre and state govts. Amid the absence of official information, there are plenty of reports and rumours that have taken their place," he added. The demand comes weeks after NTA cancelled NEET-UG 2026 on May 12 after central agencies confirmed the examination had been compromised. A re-examination has been scheduled for June 21. Singh referred to concerns raised by students regarding the status of earlier investigations. He cited reports that Sanjeev Kumar alias Mukhya, accused in the NTA UG paper leak case in Hazaribagh, was out on bail. He also pointed to reports that the CBI had filed a closure report in the UGC-NTA 2024 case despite the examination having been cancelled by NTA.

The Congress functionary proposed that the white paper include details of all paper leaks and irregularities in NTA examinations, arrests made, action taken by investigative agencies, investigation status, charge sheets or closure reports filed, reasons for closure reports of accused persons. "Such an agency will act as a confidence-building measure among youth," Singh wrote.

FIR against 'Khan Sir' over firing outside his Bihar coaching institute



Patna: Police in Patna, Bihar, filed an FIR against registered educator Faisal Khan, popularly known as "Khan Sir" and two others over June 2 firing and vandalism incident outside his coaching institute. The FIR invokes Section 109 (abetment) of BNS, along with sections of Arms Act.

aprons used have been seized and forwarded to Forensic Science Laboratory for examination. Patna Police have also issued an appeal to the student community, urging them not to get swayed by professional rivalries. "All students are requested not to be misled by anyone amid coaching centre competitions. No compromise will be made regarding crime control and the maintenance of law and order," police said. Large numbers of aspirants were seen waiting outside the coaching centre and shouting slogans in protest as tension prevailed following the incident in which a security guard was reportedly injured. "We want justice. We want security. We want security," a student said.

Circulated leaked NEET papers: CBI opposes bail plea of Wagmare

New Delhi: CBI Friday informed a Delhi court that Manisha Sanjay Wagmare, an accused in NEET paper leak case, circulated question papers to students for monetary consideration. "She gave students questions from physics, chemistry and biology papers. We have statements from students that they paid money in exchange for the leaked papers. Wagmare circulated the question papers," CBI said. The court reserved the order on the plea for June 9. Her counsel, however, argued that his 47-year-old client did not indulge in any illegal activity and that no cash was recovered from her premises, neither was anything incriminating found on her phones. Wagmare was arrested on May 14 and is in judicial custody.

JEE authorities deny mass leak of candidates' data

New Delhi: JEE (Advanced) authorities Friday said a cloud storage misconfiguration earlier this week did not result in any mass extraction of candidate data and had no impact on examination records, results or rankings.

The affected storage was read only, meaning no data could be edited or deleted. An analysis of cloud access logs confirmed that no bulk download occurred. IIT-Roorkee

Ministry of education also reported suggesting a large-scale breach. "As per the clarification issued by IIT Roorkee, the ministry reiterates that no sensitive information was compromised, and the examination outcomes, marks, and candidate information remain completely secure, intact, and safe," it said.

SC halts possible deportation of 2 Assam women

New Delhi: Supreme Court Friday stayed the possible deportation of two individuals - Saleha Khatun and Sarbanu Begum - who are alleged to have been detained after being declared foreigners by a Foreigners Tribunal in Assam. Both women have been lodged in Goalpara detention centre since March 2026.

SC also issued a notice to Centre and sought its response on pleas filed by the two detainees, who have been declared foreigners. Saleha and Sarbanu are alleged to be pre-1971 Indian citizens reflected in electoral records and NRC legacy data.

her claim was rejected on the basis of minor discrepancies in names and records. She also argues that HC mechanically affirmed the tribunal's findings without properly examining evidence. Sarbanu said she had produced documents and oral evidence establishing her citizenship.

Collegian trolled for dumping trash on roadside dies by suicide in Goa

Goa: A 23-year-old college student who was trolled for dumping trash on the roadside died by suicide in Goa after he faced a viral video of himself.

Chief minister Dr Pramod Sawant said Samuel's death was unfortunate, and that he had directed police to conduct a thorough investigation into the matter. Talking to reporters Friday, Samuel's family members said he went into depression after being trolled on social media over the video.

A complaint was also filed against him at Mapusa police station over his action, family members added. A senior police officer said an FIR was filed against Samuel under BNS section 271 (negligent acts likely to spread infection of a disease dangerous to life) and also under Goa Biodegradable Garbage Control Act.

Police: Cockroach Janta Party didn't take nod for protest; lk cops deployed

New Delhi: Police in Delhi said Friday they have not received any request for permission from Cockroach Janta Party (CJP) regarding its proposed protest at Jantar Mantar Saturday even as more than 1,000 police personnel have been deployed in the national capital. "We will examine their request if and when they seek permission," a police officer told PTI.

Police sources said they learnt about the proposed protest through social media posts and messages circulating online, and added that they have to receive any formal communication from the Abhi-jeet Dipke-led outfit.

Police said they are closely monitoring the situation and making preliminary security arrangements in view of the proposed gathering. All district units have been placed on standby and further decisions are likely after evaluating intelligence inputs and the ground situation, sources said. Police officers described the situation as 'very dynamic,' with assessments being conducted at multiple levels.
